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These authors have argued that the *deontological* approach to ethics is based on the idea that there are certain principles or rules that are morally binding, regardless of the consequences of following them. In contrast, the *consequentialist* approach to ethics is based on the idea that the morality of an action is determined by its consequences. In other words, an action is morally right if it results in the greatest good for the greatest number of people.
